- VI. To acquire, purchase or otherwise own or take on lease or hire any movable or immovable property necessary for the proper discharge of the objectives of the association
- VII. To mobilize funds for the Association to carry out its activities in furtherance of its objectives
- VIII. To invest and deal with the funds/assets of the Association.
- IX. To do all such other lawful things that are conducive or incidental to the attainment of the above objectives and /or beneficial to the interest of the School and its Alumni.

## 6. Membership.

- I. All the students (with at least one year of stay at school), who were part of the Batch that has passed out of the school each year is defined as an alumnus eligible to be the member of the Association. They must register with the Association, by paying Membership registration fee, so as to be a recognized member in legal terms.
- II. Every alumnus can become the member of the association by paying a onetime lifetime subscription of Rs.1000 [Rupees thousand only] or by paying Rs.100(Rupees hundred only) every year as annual subscription fee with the following exceptions;
- III. The alumnus from the last 10 batches will be exempted from paying the membership fee, who will be member of the association for 10 years and thereafter they will have to pay either the lifetime membership fee or the annual subscription fees to continue as a member.
- IV. Annual membership holders shall pay RS.1000 to become lifetime member irrespective of the annual fee they had paid till date.
- V. The membership fee shall be collected by each batch representative who are members of the executive council and will be credited to the account of the Association or the members can directly transfer the membership fee to the account of the Association with intimation to the Executives members from each batch.
- VI. The membership and subscription fees are subject to revision from time to time with the approval of the General Body.
- VII. A Register/an electronic data base of the members enrolled into the association by paying the prescribed fee shall be kept at the office of the Association.
- VIII. If a member changes his/her postal and/or e-mail address, he/she shall notify his/her new address to the Alumni Association Office, and the entry in the registry shall be accordingly changed; but if he/she fails to notify his/her new address, the address in the roll of members shall be deemed to be his/her address.
- IX. The executive council may cease any individual's status as a member in the event of his or her death, resignation, becoming of unsound mind, or in the event of his /her conviction of a criminal offence involving moral turpitude.
- X. The Executive Council shall have power to expel an office bearer and /or member for willful disregard to the association's rules or misconduct on the part of the member, provided that the member concerned will be given an opportunity for explaining his conduct, which should be ratified by the General Body.
- XI. Resignation from membership shall be tendered to the President and it shall not take effect until it has been accepted on behalf of the Association by the executive Council.
- XII. The membership fee shall not be refundable either on resignation or termination.

## 7. Organizational Structure

I. **General Body:** The GENERAL BODY consists of all Alumni who have subscribed to the membership of the association by paying the prescribed fee and shall be the Supreme Authority in all matters pertaining to the Association. The Broad functions of the General Body will be;


- a. To approve the annual report and the audited statement of accounts of the Association for the previous financial year ending, 31st March.
- b. To elect the members of the Executive Council of the association (Two members to the Council to be elected by each batch).
- c. To discuss, and resolve matters of general interest to the members which may be placed before the meeting or any other matter for which seven days' notice has been received from any member, subject to the permission of the chair.
- d. To amend/alter the bye laws of the association.


II. **Executive Council (EC):** The administration of the Association shall vest in the hands of Executive Council of the Association consisting of two Batch representatives unanimously elected from each Alumni Batch during the AGM. Executive Council should consist of not less than 10 members, of which, shall include One President, One Vice President, One Secretary, One Joint Secretary and One Treasurer. In order to maintain an odd number executive council for the purpose of avoiding ambiguity during voting and decision making it is decided to have three batch representatives from the First Batch (1986-'93) to the Executive Council.


- a. The EC will also serve as the point of contact for their respective batches. All communication to the batch shall be done through respective EC members through any established mode of communication through online platforms. They also have the responsibility to mobilize membership /funds etc from the respective batches.
- b. The Executive Council shall have the right to co-opt members and/or appoint sub- committees from amongst the General body from time to time for execution of any Special project/assignment.
- c. The Executive Council shall be responsible for all the finances and funds of the association and shall give effect to the plans and programmes of the Association and shall have the authority to carry them out. No individual can take any decision without consulting the Executive Council in managing the activities of the Association. None of the members of the Council/Association will be paid for his/ her work.

III. **Office Bearers:** The Association will have a President, Vice President, Secretary, Jt. Secretary and a Treasurer elected by and from among the members of Executive Council by nomination and show of hands.

- a. **President:** President shall be an alumnus of more than 10 years standing- He/She Overlooks the functions of the Association. Will be responsible for all the actions of the Executive Council and has a role in all matters and is the point of contact for the school. In the absence of President, Vice President will act as the President.
- b. **Secretary (Alumnus of at least 10 years of standing):** The Secretary shall be responsible for the safe custody of the records of the association. The Secretary shall look after all the formalities of the Association. He/ she will be responsible for the documentation of all the activities of the Association. Gen sec is liable to maintain all the expenditure related issues. He shall convene the meetings of the Executive Council as well as the GBM as and when necessary and shall perform all the functions assigned by the Executive council to him. He shall coordinate all the events, functions and activities of Association. He shall interact all the required persons to

discharge the duties of association. He shall represent the association in any legal action of the association and shall carry on all correspondence on behalf of the association.

- c. Treasurer (Alumnus of at least 10 years of standing): Treasurer shall keep the Books and accounts of the Association and ensure proper utilization of funds in a most efficient way. He /she is liable to maintain the financial transparency of the association and liaise with the banks and financial institutions. He shall present the accounts to all the members during the Annual meet. Every registered member of the association has the right to ask for financial expenditure of the association.
- d. Apart from the President, Secretary and Treasurer, a Vice President and Joint Secretary will also be elected from among the Executive Council to carry out the roles of the President and Secretary respectively in their absence and to assist them in all the activities of the Association.
- e. An Office Bearer Stepping down from that position any time for personal reasons shall continue to be an EC Member and the election to fill vacant Office Bearer positions will be conducted simply by the elected EC members amongst themselves within 30 days of vacation of office.

#### 8. Term of Office:

- I. The office bearers and members of the Executive Council will be elected for a period of two years. (Calendar year).
- II. Members are eligible for reappointment, but can serve as Executive Council members for a maximum of two consecutive terms, after which they need to have a break of at least two terms to get re-elected.
- III. In the event there is an interim period between the expiry of term of the existing EC, and the installation of the new EC, for whatever reason, the old Executive Council shall be entitled to remain in office as a Caretaker EC, until the next elected EC is ready to take charge of the management of the association including all assets and liabilities as on the date of the take over from the outgoing Council. The period of such Caretaker operation shall not exceed 30 days. During this interim period the outgoing Executive Council shall not take decisions on financial or policy matters of the association.

#### 9. Meetings, Quorum and Voting rights

- I. As the Association meetings (both ECM and GBM) call for participation of Alumni across the globe, the meetings may be physical/ virtual online meetings or a combination of both using internet facilities or audio and video conferences and the mode of communication of meeting shall also be by any recognized mode of communication through online platforms. The secretary shall broadcast such information to the Executive members who in turn shall communicate the same to the respective batches.
- II. The Annual General Body Meeting (AGM) of the Association shall be held in the month of December every year, no later than 31<sup>st</sup> December every year, preferably along with the annual Alumni meet at the School premises or at such notified place and at such time and date as the Executive Council may determine to transact the business of the association.
- III. At least 30 days' notice shall be given for holding the Annual General Body Meeting. The Secretary's report and the audited statement of accounts of the preceding financial year shall be circulated and/or posted through the EC/batch representatives at least seven days prior to the date of Annual General Body Meeting.
- IV. GBM of the association can be convened by the Secretary as and when necessary by giving 15 days' notice to the members through the Executive Council members of respective batches. The meeting details shall also

be updated through the website of the association.

- V. The Executive Council shall meet quarterly and also as and when necessary, preferably through virtual meetings which will be communicated by the secretary through 'whats app' broad casts or through any other established mode of communication at least 7 days prior to the schedule. Extra-ordinary council can be held for discussing urgent matters with 24 hours' notice.
- VI. The members can send the proposals/issues to be discussed in the EC meeting to the President/Secretary, which will be compiled as agenda by the Secretary and will be circulated among the members along with the notice of meeting. Any matters not included in the agenda can be discussed by the Council at the discretion of the Chair (President).
- VII. **Quorum** for a GBM should be a minimum of 100 members physically or virtually present.
- VIII. Quorum for the Executive Council shall be 1/3 of its members.
- IX. Every Alumnus Member shall have one vote and can cast their votes on the motions / agenda items, via internet in the poll which will be kept open for a minimum of 3 days prior to the GBM/AGM. The President of the Association shall be the Chairman of the meeting, and in case of equality of votes, the President shall have a casting vote. A member shall not vote by proxy. Physical voting can be done through Voice Vote or by rising vote during the meeting who has not exercised their voting rights in the online poll

#### 10. Bank Account


- I. A bank account in the name of the Association shall be opened in any of the nationalized banks which could be operated jointly by the President, Secretary and Treasurer under dual signature of any two.
- II. The details of the account, balance-expenditure statements etc shall be placed before the executive council by the treasurer during every quarterly meeting.
- III. Any proposal to incur expenses from the funds being maintained by the association has to be approved by the Executive Council with a 2/3 rd majority of the members present and voting and the banking transactions can be done only after such approval is accorded.
- IV. The accounts of the association shall be audited annually through the auditors appointed for the purpose.

**11. Amendments:** Any of the provisions of the By-laws may be altered /amended from time to time, if required, by the General Body of Meeting of the Association by a resolution carried by a majority of two-thirds of the votes of its total members present and voting. The agenda should reach all its members at least 10 days prior to the date fixed for the voting. The amendments to be carried out shall be subject to the provisions under section 12 of this the Societies Registration Act No. 21 of 1860.


**12. Dissolution:** If, on the winding up or dissolution of the Association, there shall remain, after the satisfaction of all its debts and liabilities, any property whatsoever the same shall be dealt in accordance with decision of the Special GBM to be convened for the purpose. The amendments to be carried out shall be subject to the provisions under Section 13 & 14 of the Societies Registration Act No. 21 of 1860.


#### 13. Suits and Proceedings by and against the Association

- IV. and properties of the Association alone.




- I. The following records shall be maintained by the Association.

- IV. The destruction of the old documents will be done periodically in accordance with the standard procedures.






- I. **Alumni:** shall be read and understood as "alumni/alumnae" and "alumnus" shall be read and understood as "alumnus/alumna"

- V. **School:** The School refers to Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya, Calicut.


